**Action Report**

May 15, 2020

- I. ACTION-Applications for the 2020-21 scholarships were reviewed and evaluated. The committee recommends 7 scholarships in the amount of \$35,000. The committee recommends a \$4,000 scholarship award for each student for the 2020-21 school year; with the ability to request an additional \$1,000 supplemental grant, contingent on their need, based on the effect of COVID-19 on their financial situation.
