Congratulations! On behalf of the Louisiana Bar Foundation (LBF) Kids' Chance Scholarship Program, you have been awarded a scholarship in the amount of \$ for the 2023-24 school year, contingent on your Spring 2023 grades.

The scholarship may be used for tuition, books, fees, housing and general living expenses. After the requirements listed below are met, payments will be sent directly to your school in two equal installments in August 2023 and January 2024. - Copy of your full-time Fall 2023 class schedule
- Copy of Financial Aid letter from the school you are attending 2023-24
- Your official transcript from Spring 2023*

Jan. 2024 check will be released once the LBF receives the following: **(deadline Jan. 12, 2024)**

- Copy of your full-time Spring 2024 class schedule
- Your official transcript from Fall 2023*

*For official transcripts, please visit your school's Registrar's office and request they send your official transcript to: faith@raisingthebar.org or LBF Kids' Chance Scholarship Program, 1615 Poydras Street, Suite 1000, New Orleans, LA 70112.

Funds will not be released to the school until all of the above conditions are met. This is your responsibility. If you do not have one or more of these items by the deadline, you must contact the LBF office before the deadline at 504-561-1046.

A press release will be sent to your local newspaper to inform them that you are a scholarship recipient.

Kids' Chance Scholarship Program Acceptance Agreement

This award is contingent upon the following terms and conditions:

1. This agreement must be completed, signed and returned to the LBF office by **Friday, June 9, 2023**.
2. The Louisiana Bar Foundation (LBF) will release a check in Aug. 2023 and in Jan. 2024 for \$ for a combined total of \$ payable to the college or university listed below. **Checks will be released upon your approval and acceptance of these scholarship terms, indicated by your signing of this Acceptance Agreement and returning it and other required items to the LBF office.**
3. This scholarship requires recipients to agree to maintain satisfactory grades (2.0 GPA).
4. This scholarship requires recipients to be enrolled full-time as defined by your school.
5. August 2023 checks will be released once the LBF has received the following: **(deadline is July 14, 2023)**
 - Copy of your full-time Fall 2023 class schedule
 - Copy of Financial Aid letter from the school you are attending 2023-24
 - Your official transcript from Spring 2023
6. January 2024 checks will be released once the LBF has received the following: **(deadline January 11, 2024)**
 - Copy of your full-time Spring 2024 class schedule
 - Your official transcript from Fall 2023
7. You will inform the Kids' Chance Scholarship Program if you withdraw from school for any reason. The college or university will return the unused portion of the scholarship to the LBF.
8. You agree to let the Kids' Chance Scholarship Program and the LBF use for outreach purposes your name, picture, story, and any statements you make about the value of the Kids' Chance Scholarship. We are a not-for-profit organization and rely on donations from businesses, individuals, and fund-raising events to fund the scholarship you are receiving.
9. You may from time to time be contacted by members of the Kids' Chance Program, offering interaction with other Kids' Chance scholars, or inquiring into your academic performance and the value of the Program to you. Your participation in such outreach is entirely voluntary.
