Louisiana Bar Foundation Presented with 2025 Social Justice Champion Award

(New Orleans, Louisiana) The Louisiana Bar Foundation (LBF) was recognized as the 2025 Social Justice Champion by the Gillis Long Poverty Law Center at Loyola University New Orleans College of Law. Each year, the Center recognizes an organization that partners with Loyola's College of Law to advance justice in the community.
